BURNLEY HALF MARATHON ON THIS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 2

The penultimate event of the XCR'12 season is the state half marathon championship to be held at Burnley on Sunday morning starting at 8:00am. There will be a junior 3km event (to replace 3k from Flemington earlier in the year where the course was incorrect).

The races start and finish adjacent to Kevin Bartlett Reserve.

Yarra Boulevard will be closed to traffic, but parking is available at the rear of the Bottanica Office Complex at 572 Swan St. Burnley.

Please arrive early in order to find a park and have plenty of time to get to the start line.

Don't forget that you must wear your AV bib numbers AND your timing chip. It is possible to get replacement numbers and a replacement chip on the day, if you have misplaced yours. Please arrive early if this is going to be necessary.

NATIONAL CROSS COUNTRY

Box Hill had a number of great performances in the national cross country championships in Adelaide last weekend. Of particular note was the outstanding run by Chris Hamer in winning the silver medal in the men's open 12km event just one second behind the winner. In tough muddy and windy conditions Chris was always near the front and almost broke away before just being outkicked by James Nipperness of NSW. Box Hill also picked up third place in the

national teams event with Steve Dinneen and John Meagher joining Chris Hamer to make up the team.

Julie Norney continued her great form placing 15th in the women's open event. Special mention also to new member Georgia Hansen who finished 13th in the women's Under 16 race.
